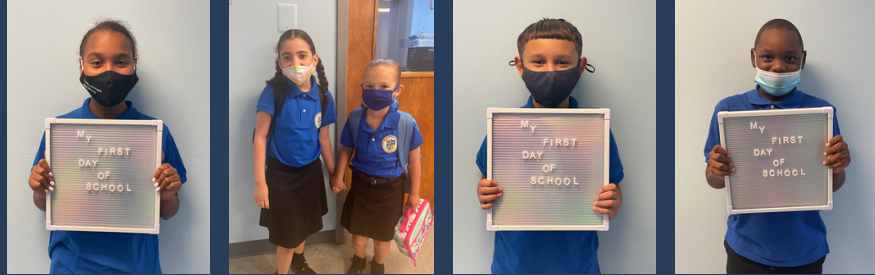
New Student Orientation

On Monday, August 30th, we welcomed 30 new first grade cadets to our elementary school. The cadets met the administrators, their new teachers, and classmates.



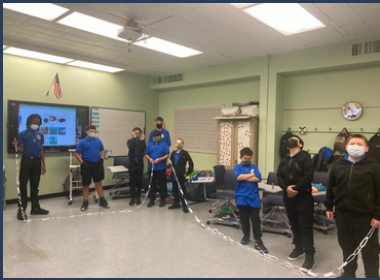
First Day of School!

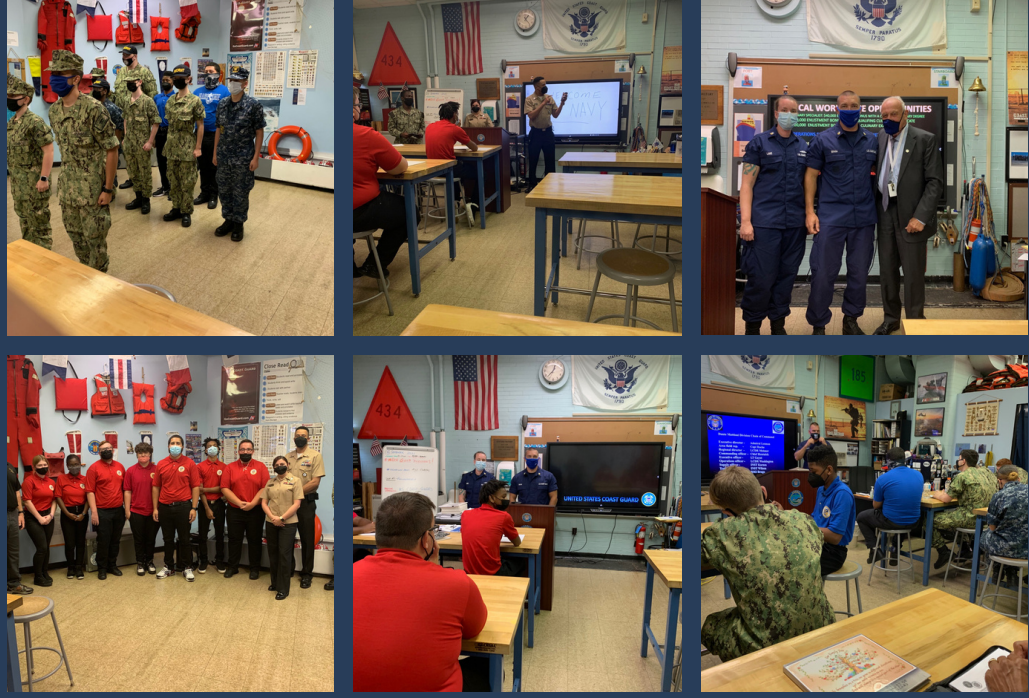
